The Early Learning Center at Hull Circle will provide affordable, high-quality childcare and early education in a safe and nurturing environment while also connecting families to critical wraparound services that help address barriers faced by working families and low-income households. These services may include family support programs, workforce development resources, housing assistance, nutrition services, and other community-based supports aimed at helping families achieve long term stability and economic mobility.

MCCAA has operated its award-winning Head Start program for more than 40 years, serving more than 500 children annually across 12 counties throughout the Mid-Cumberland region. While the Early Learning Center at Hull Circle is separate from MCCAA's federally funded Head Start program, the new center reflects the agency's continued commitment to expanding access to affordable, high quality educational opportunities for children and families across the community.

The transition also represents the first step in a broader vision to expand affordable, high quality early learning centers throughout the region in order to meet the growing needs of children and working families.

Mid-Cumberland Community Action Agency remains committed to strengthening communities by empowering individuals and families through education, opportunity, and comprehensive support services. The launch of the Early Learning Center at Hull Circle represents another important step forward in the agency's mission to help families build stronger and more stable futures.
